CSNA is comprised of seven major programs, each of which has specific goals and objectives within the framework of the parent agency.

The Crisis Services Program is made up of several sub-programs including Volunteer Services, the HOPE Place First Responder Program, HELPLine's Rape Response and HELPLine's 24-hour crisis line. Individual and group counseling is offered to people in personal crisis.
